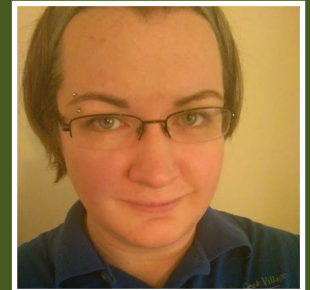
A Note from Lori

What do you like most about living at Timber Creek Village: The people are so nice!

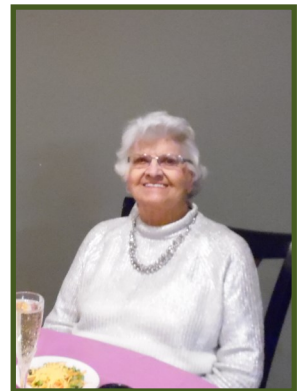
Lorena Michael
